Increase in Fees at Wivelsfield Wrens Nursery

We are now coming to the end of our second year of running the Wivelsfield Wrens Nursery, and we are so pleased with how it has continued to grow and become part of our school community.

Following the increase in costs associated with running the Nursery, we have reviewed our offering and we will be increasing our session costs from September 2025. We have benchmarked these against other settings in the surrounding area and believe that these increases are in line with them and still remain competitive.

To try to keep your costs down we have kept our sundry contributions the same as this year.
