Dear Parents and Carers,

Sports Day Wednesday 23rd June

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our Sports Day next Wednesday and having an enjoyable time as a school community.

It appears there is a significant increase in cases of Covid 19 in the Mid Sussex area and in light of this we will be strictly implementing the DfE guidance for sports days as shown below.

Spectators must adhere to current social distancing requirements. Where events take place outdoors, spectators can gather in separate groups of up to 30 – the legal gathering limit. Multiple groups of 30 are permitted.

You will be issued with a coloured ticket on admittance to the school and must sit in that colour zone on the field. In each zone you must adhere to social distancing and 'sign in' so that we are test and trace compliant.

Because of increased testing and cases in the area, you should be aware that if you attend you are increasing the chance of being contacted by test and trace and asked to self isolate. This is why it is essential you remain in your group of 30. This also means you will not be able to follow your child around when they do their multi skills events, but hopefully you will be able to see them, albeit from a bit of a distance.

To manage the day more smoothly, we have also decided to hold Robins 'Sports Day' on their own at the end of the school day. They will be able to watch Hedgehogs and Rabbits before their event.

Robins: 2.05 – 3.00pm

Unless you have a child in Hedgehogs or Rabbits, we are now asking Robins parents not to come to school until just before 2.00pm.

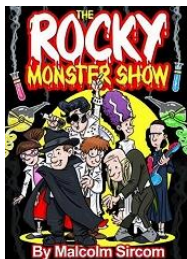


Key Stage Two timings will remain as previously published.
