Frequently asked questions:

Does my child need to keep a PE kits at school?

Robins will have PE on Friday mornings and will be asked to come into school wearing their school PE, possibly with a track suit over the top if it is colder, however, please wear school shoes. Children can leave a named pair of PE plimsoles/trainers on their peg which they will change into. We will not be starting PE until the children are more settled and in full time (week beginning 5th October).

Where do the children come into school?

The Robins will use the KS1 entrance gate in the mornings (8:50) which enters straight into the Reception cloakroom. Please see the attached video to show your Robin where to go. The children will be collected at the end of the day from the front entrance (3pm).

What does my child need to bring to school everyday?

Children will need a named book bag daily as letters, reading books and learning will be sent home frequently. Children will also need named water bottle. This will be kept in the classroom and easily accessible.

What clothes does my child need to wear for Forest School?

More information regarding Forest School dates and clothing will be sent out closer to the time, however, please ensure your child has a named pair of wellies (that can be kept at school) and a waterproof coat.
