Foxes trip for Fishbourne Roman Palace

We are pleased to announce that Foxes will be visiting the historic and fantastic **Fishbourne Palace on Tuesday 12th July**, for our **Fantastic Finish** to our **Romans** topic. Being able to immerse children in a 'Roman civilisation environment' will develop their knowledge of the topic. During the trip, the children will take part in a workshop that showcases how Roman children were educated. We will also learn the history of Fishbourne, who lived there, why it was built and when it was erected.

We plan to leave school at 9am prompt so the children will need to be in school for 8.40 am please. We will then travel by coach, returning to school by 3:30pm. If there are any delays to our arrival we will contact you all via e-schools. Children should be collected from the **KS2 entrance at 3:30pm**.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch (ideally in a rucksack), a snack and a drink which should not be fizzy or in a glass bottle. We will be outside some of the day, and on foot for most of it, therefore we suggest the children wear comfortable, sensible trousers and trainers. However, for easy identification, they must wear school uniform 'tops'. Please ensure your child is appropriately dressed for the day's weather e.g. sun cream/sunhat/warm coat/wet weather gear. We ask that children do not bring any spending money on the day.

To help cover the costs of this event, we are asking for a one-off contribution of **£21.50 to be submitted via ParentPay by Tuesday 29th June** (families who fall within the pupil premium category are not asked to contribute).
